INTRODUCTION

This Scripture was revealed to me over a period of a few days in August 2023. God had been telling me for several months that there was going to be a new Scripture for humanity, but I didn't expect it to be revealed so soon.

The experience of receiving this Scripture was as follows. I would adopt a praying posture with my eyes closed and my hands together and sit silently observing the thoughts that came to mind. After a short period, normally just a few seconds, my energy would shift into a state that was high and pure, and God would speak a single sentence to my mind in a distinct voice. I would then write the sentence down word for word.

God revealed a few sentences at a time over a period of a few days. After each revelation, a deep peace manifested in my surroundings. The wind and trees became very still and there was a profound quietness.

The order of the revealed chapters was not as they are recounted above. I later arranged the chapters into the above order after praying for God to guide me in this process. The chapter and verse numbers are not part of the revelation, they are only for reference.

The unusual presentation of the word 'God' in two instances in Chapter 7 was included prayerfully. In the initial copy, the 'o' in God was written with a small horizontal line in the top third of the circle. I believe the circle represents Almighty God and the line (presented here as a dot) represents Steven.

CHAPTER 1
